Ice, T-shirts, caps and one-of-a-kind gift items are available at the Texas State Parks Store located in our park headquarters building.

Please Note:

To help make everyone's camping stay safe and enjoyable, as well as protect the park and its natural beauty, please observe the following:

- CHECK OUT time is 2 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability).
- Public consumption or display of an open container of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- A maximum of eight people permitted per campsite. Guests must leave the park by 10 p.m. Quiet time is from 10 p.m. - 6 a.m.; during this time any loud noise that can be heard outside a respective campsite is prohibited.
- Excess parking fee is required at campsites with more than two vehicles (including trailers).
- · Campsite must be kept clean; all trash must be picked up before you leave. Dumpsters are conveniently located on all camping loops.
- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT DUMP STATIONS.
- · Only one unit per site is permitted to hook up to utilities. Vehicles must remain on roads or designated parking areas; no driving on sand dunes.
- · Pets must be kept on leash and must not be left unattended or create a disturbance. Please pick up after them. Pets are not allowed in public buildings.
- · Regulations prohibit the possession or discharge of fireworks, firearms, crossbows and arrows, air or gas weapons, slingshots or any device capable of exploding, or causing injury or killing within the state park.

Park Boundary

- · Valid permit required on windshield of each vehicle in park.
- · Numbered sites for overnight camping only. NO PICNICKING.
- · Permit required for all areas. Speed limits are posted and radar enforced.
- No camping permitted in all areas west of State Hwy. 361.



Security Gate Information: Mustang Island State Park now has a security gate designed to control traffic at night and provide an extra measure of protection to our guests and

their property. The following information will allow you to enter and leave at your convenience should you arrive after the gate is closed or need to leave before it is open in the morning. Normally the gate will be locked at 10 p.m. and opened at 7 a.m.

- Call the park the day of or the day before your arrival to get the current combination.
- · To open, enter the combination on the bottom of the lock, push in on the lock and pull.
- Open the gate, drive through and close the gate.
- · Please re-lock by changing the numbers on the lock and closing the lock securely.
