

MAGOFFIN HOME

This striking Victorian-era adobe structure entices visitors through a tree-lined walkway. Magoffin Home State Historic Site explores one family's experience with American expansion, West Texas settlement, travel on the Santa Fe Trail, Civil War turmoil and U.S-Mexico relations. The home was built after Magoffinsville, an early Anglo-American settlement in present-day El Paso, was destroyed by floods. It is a prime example of Territorial-style architecture, which embellishes native adobe with Victorian touches inside and out. Visitors explore the 20-room home with original Eastlake furnishings that reflect the refined life of a prominent pioneer family.
